vitality being expressed there is evidence of an adequate amount of magnetism put into action and when careful enquiry is made as to how magnetism comes about? The last solution of the problem is that it is a force with higher power urging its operatives magnetism is simply localized electric force applied to some device. And as purpose cannot be attributed to that which merely physical it follows that the higher force must be of an intellectual kind, hence vitality and intellectuality are in close consort; we may even go a step further and say that both vitality and intellectuality are attributes of the psychic being, for there is no other fit and proper channel for them. To propose that a vitality is only a physical expression or mode of action is to ignore a vast amount of data directly bearing upon care and opening mental door-way to that subtle faculty called intuition, which is itself a high road to a host of vague suppositions. It is better, even for argument's sake, to face the whole problem, whether we like it or not. Indeed the great trouble in great arguments is to defeat the personal influencing likes and dislikes, and agree to what is best for the circuit of human existence.
