Mutokwane replies your letter and suggests that as you had asked for the money, it would be wise if you could give the names of the people you want the money from. There are many people here who can be sent home to collect the money. There are Mutenjwa, Mabalazi, Mukoyiswa, Tshakalubisi, Hlabangana, Maxegu, Qeqwana, Zililo and others. Mutokwane also asks me to tell you that Mujwapuna went home to get the money for a Suthu herbalist. Mutokwane's son is attending school at Ekukhanyeni. Mutokwane wishes you good luck.

P.S. : Mukoyiswa says out of five pound (£5) sent to you from Sikobo, one pound was for Maboya, another pound for Mutakati and three pounds for Sikobobo.
